Rev. Clarence Casteel

Rev. Clarence "Junior" Casteel of Annapolis, MO passed away December 15, 2008 in Farmington, MO at the age of 81 years, 3 months, and 7 days. He was born September 8, 1927 in Annapolis, MO, a son of the late Clarence Thomas and Natella (Hampton) Casteel.
